


## Q1 Why do you park downtown?



## Q2 When do you typically come to Downtown? (Check all that apply)



### Q3 Where are your top two preferred locations to park downtown? (Pick 2)





## Q5 Right now all parking on the street is parallel parking. Would you still park on the street if it was head-in angled parking? (Like Dover)





## Q7 Is more parking enforcement needed to prevent illegal parking?



## Q8 How far would you walk from your parking spot to your destination?



## Q9 How long do you typically need to park in downtown for?


