## <u>MINUTES</u>

#### 1. Call to Order

Mayor Jean called the City Council Workshop to order at 7:12 PM, Deputy City Clerk Marcia Roddy took a silent roll call. All Council members were present, with the exception of Councilor Larochelle, who had been excused.
