# **Minutes**

## 1. Call to Order

Mayor McCarley called the City Council Hearing to order at 7:01 PM.

## 2. Roll Call

Deputy City Clerk Cassie Givara took the roll call. All Councilors were present, except for Councilor Lachapelle who recused himself from the hearing.

## 3. Taxi Cab License Denial Appeal Hearing

Mayor McCarley invited anyone wishing to speak on behalf of the petitioner to come forward.

Edward Donnell, Owner of Frank's Taxi Service, addressed Council in regards to his taxi license being denied by the City or Rochester Licensing Board. Mr. Donnell stated that he was advised by his lawyer not to say too much, but he did read a prepared statement on his own behalf. Terence O'Rourke, City Attorney, addressed Council and gave background on the Licensing Board's decision to repeal Frank's Taxi Service's license. Mr. O'Rourke stated that in the required background check done by the Board, it had come to light that Frank's Taxi service had been indicted by a grand jury on 6 felony counts of Medicaid fraud related directly to the business. He gave further information on these indictments and advised Council on the reasoning behind the businesses' license being repealed.

Mayor McCarley requested a motion to deny the appeal of Frank's Taxi Service. Councilor Walker **MOVED** to **DENY** the appeal. Councilor Rice seconded the motion. The **MOTION CARRIED** by a majority voice vote to deny the appeal of Frank's Taxi Service.
