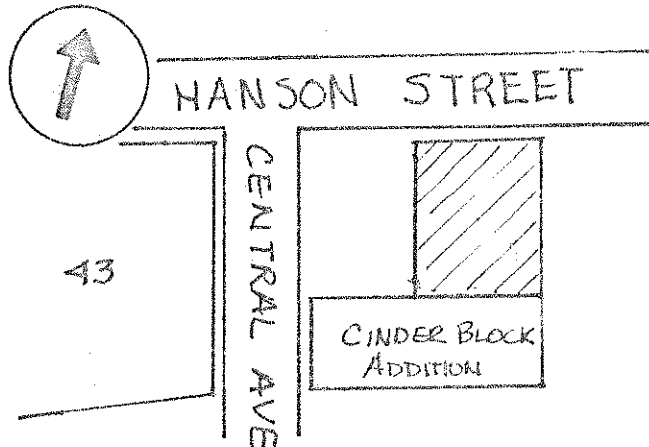

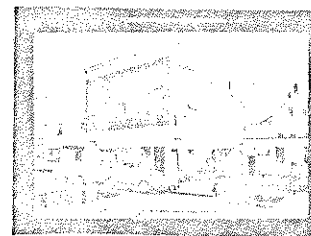

ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

A projecting bracketed cornice is the only notable architectural detail to remain on this 4 bay, 2 story Italianate style commercial block. Asphalt shingles may obscure Victorian-period surface ornamentation on the facade.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Evaluation & Historical Associations):

This building contributes to the continuity of the commercial streetscape along Hanson Street.

This Italianate commercial block was built c.1870 during development of Hanson street. Its main surviving architectural feature is its bracketed cornice. Its 20th century occupants include Honard's Auto Upolstery and presently Tony's bike shop.
