

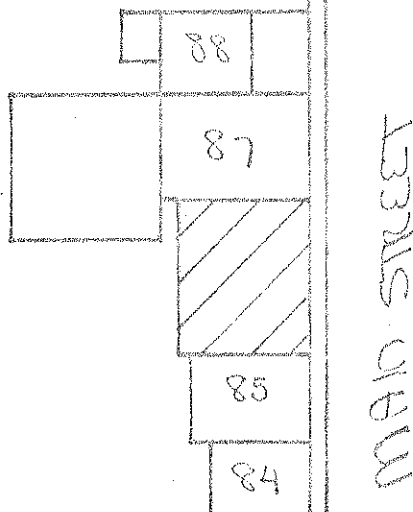

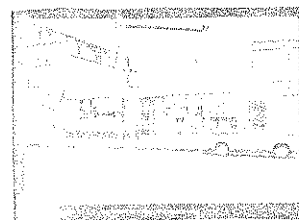

ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Carney Drugs occupies a one story 1920's commercial structure. Metal framed display windows and a sign architrave characterize the facade, which is an extensive alteration of the original. The age of the building is today illustrated only by the rear walls, which are brick, with irregularly spaced windows beneath segmental arches.

Building is in the middle of an early 20th century commercial streetscape.

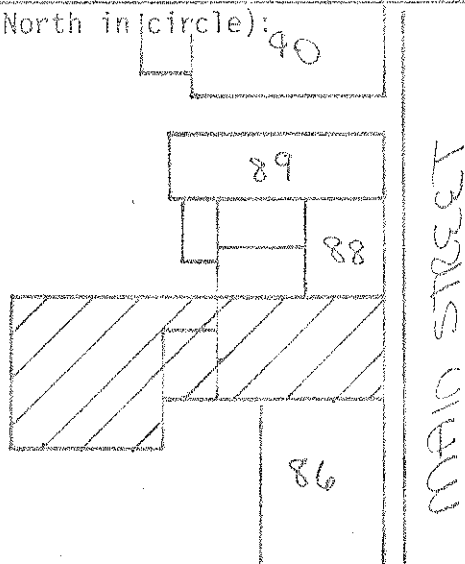

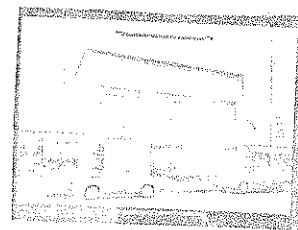

ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

With simple detailing, this is an early twentieth century commercial building characterized mainly by three rectangular windows across the second story each with a transom. The openings are topped by a brick flat arch and have stone sills below. A band of block brickwork, a pressed metal architrave and a slightly projecting cornice articulate the roofline.

The storefronts level has been altered.

RELATED STRUCTURES AND CONTEXT:

The building sits at the end of an early twentieth century commercial streetscape.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE (Evaluation & Historical Associations):

This building is one of several commercial blocks erected on North Main Street circa 1920, when the street was redeveloped for greater commercial use.
