

This vernacular Queen Anne residence is dominated by a projecting frontispiece with car sides and a polygonal roof. The corners are embellished by slender engaged columns which visually support an architrave and box cornice. The windows are topped by an unusual scrolled motif and a cap molding.	110
Dominating the first story, a former one story porch has been enclosed with brick. A simple side entry and bow window appear on the front wall.
