



ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL AND STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

The McDuffee house is a mid-nineteenth century $2\frac{1}{2}$ story 5X3 bay residence typical of urban housing of the 1850's period. Its primary feature is the central entry which is flanked by $\frac{1}{2}$ sidelights, and sheltered by a gabled pavillion added in the twentieth century. --Aluminum siding masks any other stylistic details.
