Please refer to the Application and materials for Site Plan Review for specifics regarding the Site Plan proposal and what TTC does.

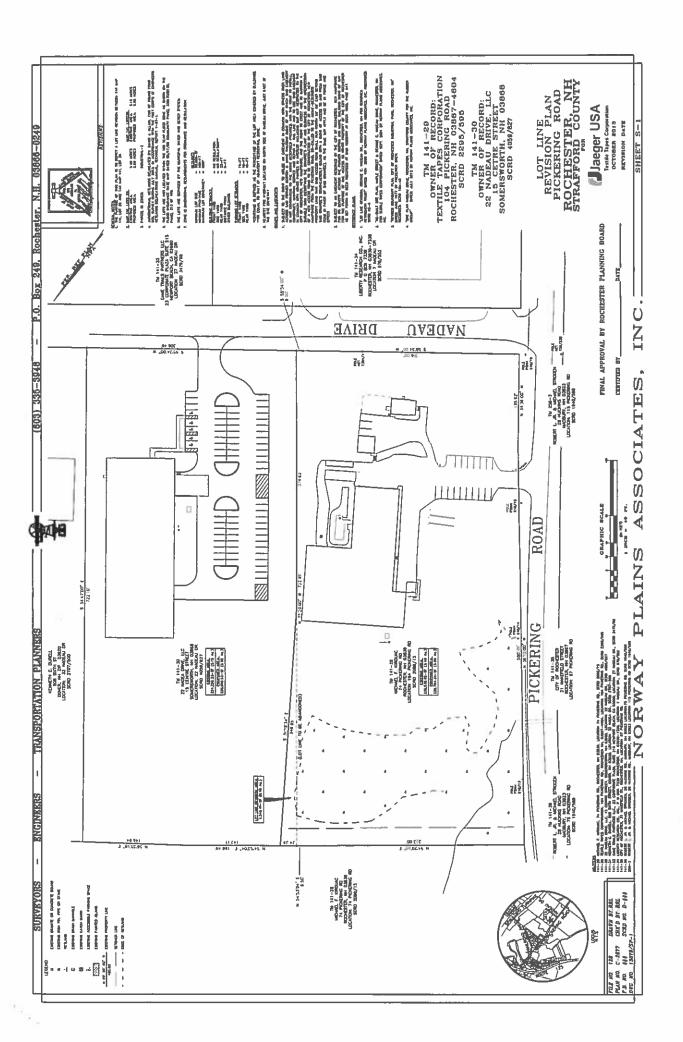
