(These are the legal minutes of the meeting and are in the format of an overview of the meeting.)

Mr. Baskerville presented a design for a cul de sac for the duplexes at Old Dover Road. He had called Chris Silk and got copies of the ledge probes.

There was discussion about making the main road a City street and a loop. There was discussion about putting the parking behind the buildings and having a park in the middle of the loop road. There are some constraints with ledge and wetlands. It was noted that parks and recreation are important.

About \$18,000 is owed to the City as part of Little Quarry. It is paid off as lots are sold.

Building a cul de sac at the end of the main road for the houses was discussed. Thee could be parking there for a trail.

The multifamily will be 2 bedroom. This generates families with small children who then move on. They may want to do some 3 bedroom later. This will be all rental. The single family will be for sale. It depends with the duplexes. The developer is trying to build a sense of community, not make a cookie cutter development.

Mr. Behrendt said adding porches would be a good idea. He said that having a loop road is very important and said it would be very difficult to meet the intent of the ordinance without a loop road as this would help to integrate the single family and multifamily.

Mr. Gray moved and Mr. Jeanson seconded approving the minutes for March 6. Motion carried 5-0 (with Ms. Larochelle voting). The meeting adjourned at 4:15 p.m.
