1. Call to Order

**WHETHER THE CITY SHOULD ACCEPT \$530,588.40 IN UNANTICIPATED HIGHWAY
FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE AND APPROPRIATE SAID AMOUNT**

He stated that the Public Hearing was to seek public input regarding City acceptance of \$530,588.40 appropriated by the State of NH Legislature in SB38 for the purpose of providing funds for local highway aid. The proposed streets to be paved are Clow Court, Nadeau Drive, Sampson Road, Woodside Lane and section of Portland Street further described as, Portland from Charles Street to South Main Street and Portland Street from Columbus Ave to Signal Street.
