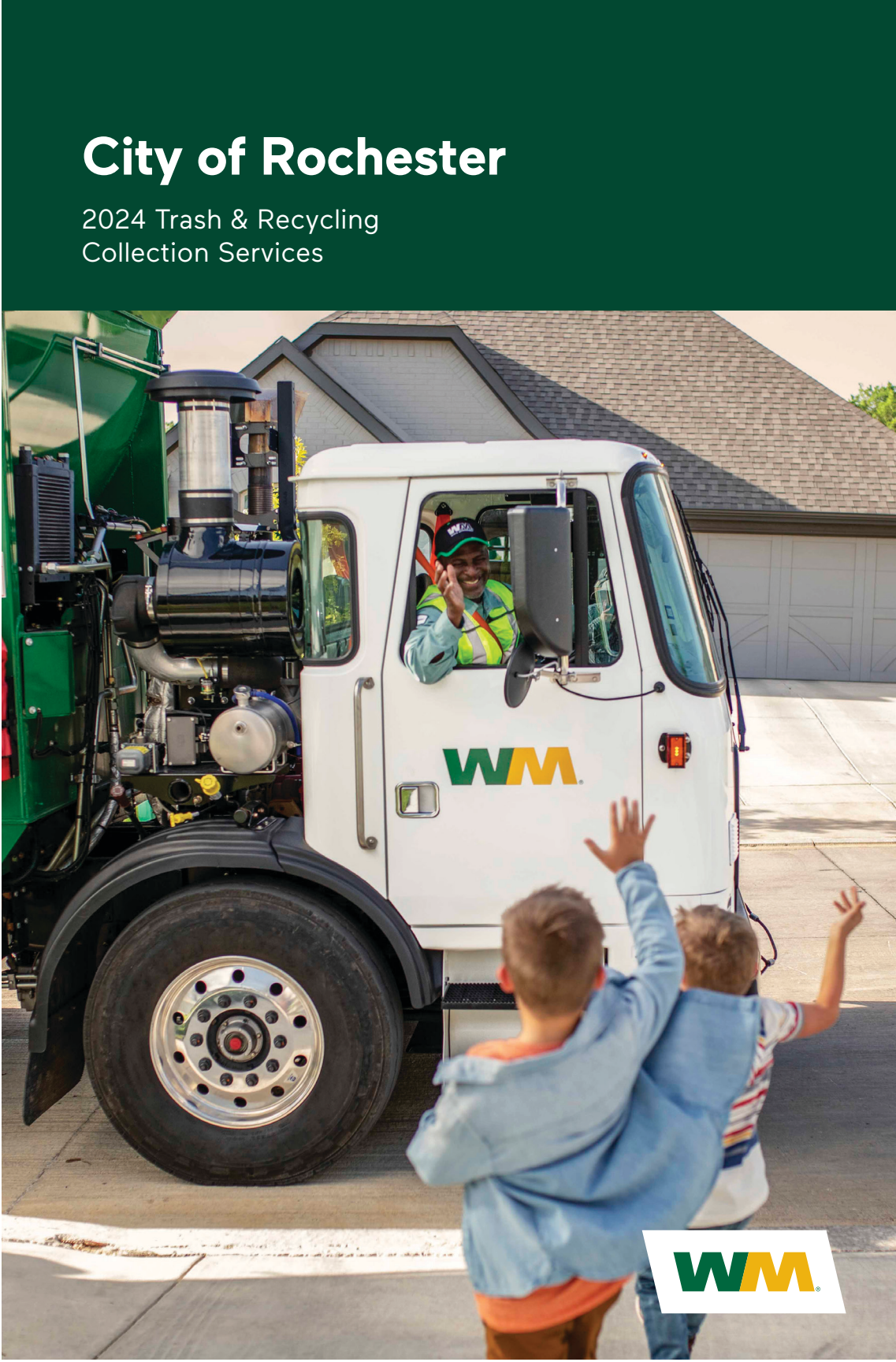

Trash and Recycling Schedule

Trash and recycling are collected weekly. All materials should be placed at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Please see the **2024** calendar on an adjacent panel that indicates special collection dates like yard waste and bulky waste.

All regular household refuse should be bagged and placed in the 64-gallon green cart for collection. Materials may not protrude from the cart and the lid must securely close.

If you have any normal household garbage that is not recyclable and does not fit into your cart, you can place the excess garbage in 30 gallon bags and affix a sticker on each bag. Stickers can be purchased at the City's Revenue Office. Bags must be brought to the Turnkey Resident Drop-off Center for disposal. Do NOT place stickered bags with curbside collections

Note: Do NOT place recyclables in the SOLID green cart

The following items will NOT be accepted in the trash cart:

- Dirt, sod, concrete or rock
- Construction, demolition debris
- Household hazardous waste
- Hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint

Leaf & Yard Waste

During the special Yard Waste collection weeks identified on the adjacent calendar, please put all leaves in paper bags for pickup on your regular trash day.

Bulky Waste

Bulky waste items can be placed on the curb the 2nd full week of each month. Please see the weeks highlighted in yellow on the enclosed Collection Calendar. No televisions or CFC containing appliances (i.e. refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers) will be accepted.

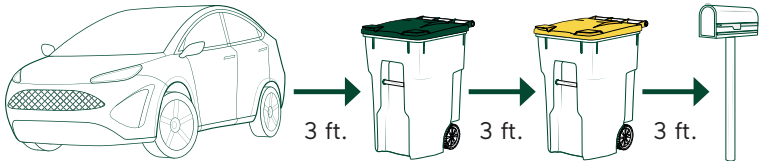

Hours: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 8:00 am – 3:00 pm and Saturday 8:00 am – 5:00 pm

- Sorted post-consumer glass, plastic, and metal.
- Flattened cardboard, newspaper, and junk mail.
- Computers equipment & televisions
- Tires without rims, 8 per year per primary personal residence (no commercial vehicle or farm equipment tires accepted)
- Leaf and yard waste – 6” or less in diameter (no stumps)
- Solid waste (must be delivered in maximum 30-gallon bags with affixed City-approved stickers purchased at the City’s Revenue Office).
- Bulky items (furniture, carpet, etc.) – 6’ x 6’ x 4’ or less.
- Construction & Demolition debris, small projects only at primary personal residence
- No CFC containing appliances accepted at this facility.

Household Hazardous Waste Day – typically held in May. Please refer to City of Rochester Department of Public Works mailer or website (www.rocheesternh.gov/public-works) for more information.

Proper Cart Placement.

Please place your cart at least 3 feet apart and 3 feet away from any obstacles (trees, cars, mailboxes, etc.) to allow the automatic arm to lift and empty the cart. Place the wheels of the cart towards the house.



Cart Repair
