Q) Where does the data originate?
A) Adobe Central 5.5.
Q) In what format?
A) PCL.
Q) Do you have a vehicle for converting the data to Postscript?
A) No, Adobe Central 5.5 converts the data to PCL.
Q) Is that part of the bid?
A) No, the machine that is selected needs to have the ability to receive a print job of 20,000 laser bills. This means that the hard drive, the memory, and the controller, on the proposed machine needs to be adequate for a job this size and be able to print at the rated speed ( 60 PPM minimum) of the machine without interruption. On a machine that is rated at 60 pages per minute, the 20,000 laser bill run needs to be completed in approximately 5.56 hours. ( $20,000 / 60$ PPM / $60=5.56$ Hours)
Q) Is the data variable?
A) Yes, varies according to number of bills in the bill run.
Q) Where does the form reside?
A) On the Windows 2003 Server.
