

INVITATION TO BID

The City of Rochester, New Hampshire, will accept sealed bids for repairing cracks and spalled concrete and encasing existing pipes in the flocculation and sedimentation basins at the Water Treatment Plant. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked:

A pre-bid meeting for Contractors interested in bidding this project will be conducted at the City's Water Treatment Plant on February 8 at 1:00 pm. Attendance is highly recommended. Coordination of work with the City is imperative so as to minimize interruption of the plant's operation and harmonize sequencing of basins under repair. The sequence of construction may require a three-week interruption in April or May to accommodate the City's flushing program. Contractor shall be responsible for all materials, temporary facilities, mobilization, labor, supervision, and equipment to perform the work, restoration and demobilization as defined in the specifications. The project's anticipated start is February 26, 2007 and must be completed no later than June 1, 2007. There will be a \$15.00 charge for bid documents. All bids must be made on the bid forms supplied, and the bid forms must be fully completed when submitted.
