Questions

- 1. In Section V, Representative Project for Section III, at the end of the first paragraph, it states that "the city desires a proposal on how to deign and implement the following project:" However, the next three paragraphs request a commentary on the Draft NHDES wasteload allocation methodology, which does not pertain to design or implementation. Is the request for design and implementation a misprint?
- 2. The scope of services #2, CMOM Program, requests an introductory cover letter. If a single firm is requesting consideration for both the CMOM and the wastewater treatment permitting and implementation projects, should a single cover letter addressing both projects be provided, or only a single cover letter, dedicated to the CMOM project. Note that a cover letter is not specifically requested for the scope of services #1.

Answers

Q1 - you could argue that it is... We are not going to have then design and implement anything at this point... We do want their commentary the wastload allocation proposal and what it would mean to the city

Q2 - cover letter can serve as a transmittal for whatever element you choose (CMOM or WWTP). Cover letter is not really a big deal
