Question:

I am one of the sprinkler contractors bidding on the Rochester Fire Department sprinkler system. As I was going through the insurance requirements for this project I noticed that there is a Combined Single Limit, Bodily Injury and Property Damage: \$5,000,000.00 aggregate. Is this correct? I am pretty sure that most of the sprinkler contractors at the walk through do not carry this much coverage. Could you please take a look at this and respond?

Answer:

The certificate of insurance amounts that are listed in items 4a, 4b, and 4c on page 9 of 13 under the "Contractor's and Subcontractor's Insurance" section are correct. I encourage potential bidders to ensure compliance with the bid document. Bidders who choose to submit an alternate bid or bid(s) may be disqualified during the review process for non-compliance.
