No late bids, faxed, e-mailed or telephone bids will be accepted. All bid questions must be submitted in writing (email preferred) to the Purchasing Agent. All bid proposals must be made on the bid proposal forms supplied, and the bid proposal forms must be fully completed when submitted.

This bid is for the construction of improvements located on 63 Pickering Road at the City's Headworks Operations building, HVAC modifications, building modifications, new gas service and on-site drainage improvements.

Completion time for the project will be calculated as calendar days from the date specified in The "Notice to Proceed" as follows:

- <u>200</u> calendar days for substantial completion.

- 2. Each General Bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid Price.
- 3. The successful bidder must furnish 100% Performance and Payment Bonds and will be required to execute the Contract Agreement within 10 days following notification of the acceptance of his bid.
- 4. Any contract or contracts awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the New Hampshire Clean Water Revolving Loan Fund (SRF).

- 5. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 entitled "Equal Employment Opportunity as amended by Executive Order 11375 and amendments or supplements to that Executive Order and as supplemented in Department of Labor Regulations (41 CFR Part 80).
