MINUTES

1. Call to Order.

Sharon Parshley called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M. Daniel Peterson and Shawn Libby were absent; all other Board members were present.

2. Acceptance of June 9, 2014 Minutes

Arthur Hoffman MOVED to accept the June 9, 2014 minutes as written. The motion was seconded and was ADOPTED by a unanimous voice vote.

3. Old Business

No old business was discussed.

4. Appeals

4.1 Avery Appeal

The appellant seeks abatement of 96 units of water due to a burst pipe in the basement when the residence was vacant. The water drained through the sump pump.

Deputy City Manager Cox recommended abatement of 96 units of sewer valued at \$599.04.

The recommendation is based upon the following findings:

- 1. The customer has documented the event of a leak and the repair.
- 2. The customer's signed application states the leaked usage did not enter the sewer system.
- 3. The usage before and after the leak was 0 units substantiating the claim that the location was vacant. The leaked usage is estimated, therefore, to be the entire 96 units measured.

Arthur Hoffman MOVED to abate 96 units of sewer fees valued at \$599.04. The motion received a second and the motion was ADOPTED on a unanimous voice vote.

4.2 Rowland Appeal

The customer seeks abatement of \$47.35 for minimum use charge. Ms. Rowland was present and offered to answer any questions that the Board might have.

The recommendation of Deputy City Manager Cox is to abate the minimum usage charge of \$47.35.

The above recommendation is based upon the following findings:

- 1. The customer has provided documentation that she was present and occupying the residence during the period the meter registered zero usage.
- 2. The City is unable to determine why the meter failed to record usage during this period.

Tom Willis **MOVED** to abate the minimum usage charge of \$47.35 and apply it to the customer's account as a credit. The motion received a second and the motion was **ADOPTED** on a unanimous voice vote.

5. Financials

The Board had a brief discussion regarding the year-to-date expenditure percentages.

6. Other

Tom Willis requested information regarding how the "minimum usage" charge is applied.

Arthur Hoffman informed the Board that a meeting of residents at Briar Ridge Estates was held to discuss the elderly exemption issue. Deputy City Manager Cox indicated that this would be an agenda item for the August Utility Advisory Board meeting.

7. Adjournment

Arthur Hoffman MOVED to adjourn the meeting. The motion received a second and the motion was ADOPTED on a unanimous voice vote.

The meeting adjourned at 5:50 P.M.

The attached appeal has been reviewed in accordance with the provisions of the City of Rochester Ordinances, Chapter 16 "Sewer Ordinance" subsection 16.18 "Appeals," and Chapter 17 "Water" subsection 17.20 "Appeals."

Recommendations

I recommend abatement of 39.25 units of sewer valued at \$244.92.

The above recommendation is based upon the following findings:

- 1. The higher than normal usage for the billing period 11-14-2013 through 02-12-2014 is the result of a leak.
- 2. There is no indication or evidence to suggest the meter readings are inaccurately high. No water abatement is needed.
- 3. The leaked usage did not enter the sewer system due to the location of the leak. Therefore, a sewer fees abatement is warranted.
- 4. The estimated leaked usage is 39.25 units.

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



The attached appeal has been reviewed in accordance with the provisions of the City of Rochester Ordinances, Chapter 16 "Sewer Ordinance" subsection 16.18 "Appeals," and Chapter 17 "Water" subsection 17.20 "Appeals."

Recommendations

I recommend abatement of 4.5 units of both water and sewer fees valued at \$49.10 for the billing period January 9, 2014 through April 3, 2014.

In addition, I recommend abatement of 35.5 units of both water and sewer fees valued at \$387.31 for the billing period April 3, 2014 through July 1, 2014.

Total abatement recommended is \$436.41.

The above recommendation is based upon the following findings:

- 1. The replacement meter installed by the City's contractor was defective in that it experienced a leak after being installed.
- 2. The average usage for the four billing periods prior to the installation of the replacement meter was 9.5. units.
- 3. The leaked usage for the April billing cycle is estimated as follows:

April Usage 14.0 Units
Average Usage - 9.5 Units
Estimated Leaked Usage 4.5 Units

4. The leaked usage for the July billing cycle is estimated as follows:

July Usage 45.0 Units Average Usage _ - 9.5 Units Estimated Leaked Usage 35.5 Units



They have requested that the City extend the reduced "Elderly" Exemption water & sewer rates to their residents. A copy of their request is attached. The Finance Committee of the City Council has referred this issue to the Utility Advisor Board for review & comment. The Water Department has determined that the model of water meter being installed at Briar Ridge does not meet the City's specifications. Hello Mr. Cox,

I work for the company that owns Lilac Community (DBA Briar Ridge Estates). We are currently installing individual water meters at each home inside of Briar Ridge, and will begin sub metering water to the residents, passing through the same rate that we are charged for the water. We will continue to receive our Master Meter bill for the entire community from the City of Rochester. (We find it to be a more fair billing process when residents pay only for the water that they use, not an "average per home" amount that is currently a part of lot rent. We also find that water consumption for the property has a whole is lower when residents pay for the amounts that they use.)

I handle setting up the utility billing systems in our company. I noticed that the City of Rochester offers a significant water rate discount to residents who qualify for the Elderly Exemption.

We would like the Briar Ridge Residents whom the City has qualified as Elderly Exempt to receive the Elderly Exempt water rate.

Would it be possible for us to submit monthly to the water department a report that lists the resident names, addresses, meter readings and dates, water used, and amount charged for those who have shown us their tax bill that indicates their Elderly Exemption status? The water department billing staff could then confirm that the residents listed are Elderly Exempt (as they do when they direct bill homeowners who qualify), and then charge us on our Master Meter bill the Elderly Exempt rate on the volume of water that we passed through to the Elderly Exempted residents. The remaining volume of water used on the Master Meter account would be at the usual residential rate.

Please give me a call to discuss, if you have any questions or concerns; we really want to make this work for our residents so they are able to take advantage of the City Program. I can set up our billing software so the monthly report is system generated, leaving little to no risk for error, and I can customize the report so you have as much or as little detail on each account as you prefer. We can also provide any other utility billing reports for your review, in the event that you would like to audit the process.
