- Is the anticipated scope of services for the project limited to an evaluation of the exterior building enclosure components associated with the steeple and clock, or are there any anticipate interior, mechanical, or electrical components to be evaluated as part of the project? The grantor has let us know that the assessment must be of the whole building with detailed emphasis on the steeple and clock in order to make sure we don't fix the steeple and then loose the underlying building!
- 2. Are hard copies and electronic copies of the RFP submission to be provided, or is one (1) submission type (either electronic or hard copies) sufficient?
