MINUTES

1. Call to Order

Also, Mr. DeNobile asked if the State had been contacted regarding the proposed TIF district as Route 11 is a State road. Fred Leonard, resident, commented on the proposed Granite Ridge TIF district. He had researched other communities across the country who had TIF districts and came to the conclusion that they are not beneficial to the cities. He said the districts do not grow and, in fact, tend to slow economic growth.

Tom Kaczynski, resident, also commented on the Granite Ridge TIF district. He said he supports growth in Rochester, but would prefer to see it as a gradual "as needed" development. He did not see the TIF district as benefiting the taxpayers or the tax rate in Rochester.
