This is given in memory of my mother Carrie H. Hussey and my aunt Wallace.

Sixth:- I give the sum of Twenty-five Hundred (2,500) Dollars to the Rochester Public Library in said Rochester, the income therefrom to be used for the purchase of non-fiction books, primarily in the field of history.

Seventh:- I give the sum of Five Thousand (5,000) Dollars to Nason College of Springvale, Maine, and direct that the same be used by the trustees of said College at their discretion as an endowment fund or for the development fund now under

Eighth:- I give my automobiles, clothing, jewelry and other articles of personal use, ornament or consumption to my sister Helen Hussey Champlin, widow of William H. Champlin of said Rochester, with the request that she make such disposition of the same as may be in accordance with any memorandum which I may leave, or with my known wishes, or as may seem to her best without imposing any obligation upon her.
