

Bequest in the Will of Priscilla J. Abbott. (Abbott Cemetery Fund)

Seventh: "I give and bequeath to the City of Rochester in trust the sum of Three Hundred Dollars, the same to be held as a trust fund forever, to keep well and safely invested, and the income to be forever expended in caring for and beautifying my family burial lot in Rochester Cemetery (so called) being number one hundred and thirty, where lie buried my Father, Mother and sisters; also my sister's grave, Mary A. Fall."

A letter from Rufus A. Shorey, Executor, dated March 18-1916 requested that the City expend on or before Memorial Day each year, from the income of said fund - Eight Dollars (\$8.00) in the purchase of cut and potted plants and One Dollar (\$1.00) in seeding, grassing and fertilizing said plot.
