Dear Mr. Bouchard:

I have enclosed a check in the amount of \$5,158.00 designed to establish the Spaulding High School Class of 1946 Fiftieth Reunion Memorial Scholarship Fund. This fund was established by the class at its fiftieth reunion this year.

It is the intention of the class that this fund be invested with other similar funds now held by the City of Rochester as Trustee, managed by its current agent, Charter Trust Company or successors, and the income only be disbursed annually to a member of the graduating class of Spaulding High School as scholarship aid for post-secondary school education in the student's chosen field of endeavor.

In the determination of the students to receive the scholarship award the following rules are to be followed to the extent practical:

- 1. The awards shall be made by the Scholarship Committee currently established at the High School, its successors or such similar group as may perform such duties in the future.
- 2. All awards shall be completely non-discriminatory with regard to race, religion, gender, age or marital and family status.
- 3. Applications for the award shall be required for consideration.

 Applications shall be in writing and in a form consistent with the forms currently used at the High School.
- 4. Each application shall be considered based on the factors of scholarship, college or other educational motivation, extra curricular activities, community involvement, ability to express oneself, financial responsibility and overall impression. Need may, but need not, be considered. Applicants related to members of the Class of 1946 shall, when practical, receive priority in evaluation.

5. Additions to the fund are encouraged and may be made by Class of 1946 members and other interested persons or organizations. Contributions should be sent to Spaulding High School, Rochester, NH, to the attention of the Principal.
