THE GLADYS GILMAN REDLON SCHOLARSHIP FUND

WHEREAS, The Rochester Historical Society through the generosity of nephews and a niece of Gladys Gilman Redlon has established the Gladys Gilman Redlon Scholarship Fund, and

WHEREAS, The City of Rochester by its Trustees for Trust Funds has agreed to administer the Fund, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Fund is to grant scholarships to Rochester high school graduating students interested in history and the history of the City of Rochester, and

WHEREAS, the Fund is established to perpetuate the tireless efforts and interest of Gladys Gilman Redlon in the history of Rochester.

NOW THEREFORE, said Scholarship Fund shall be held and administered as follows:

The Trustees of Trust Funds for The City of Rochester, hereinafter referred to as the "Administrator", shall upon recommendation of The Rochester Historical Society Scholarship Committee, hereinafter referred to as "Committee", pay the annual net income of the Fund in the form of one or more annual Gladys Gilman Redlon Scholarships to members (male or female) of the graduating class from a Rochester high school (presently Spaulding High School) who intend to attend an accredited institution of post-secondary education. Institution of post-secondary education shall mean an accredited public or private four year college, or university.

The Committee shall receive annually from the Rochester Scholarship Committee its recommendation of students eligible to receive a scholarship. The eligibility criteria for a graduating student is as follows:

- 1. Must be a resident of Rochester.
- 2. Must major in history or a related subject such as Social Sciences.
- 3. Has been accepted at a post-secondary school.
- 4. Has demonstrated an interest in Rochester history.

This scholarship shall be awarded as The Gladys Gilman Redlon Scholarship at the annual graduation exercises of a Rochester High School. The amount of the scholarship shall be determined by the Committee. Any funds not so expended shall be available toward scholarships in succeeding years.

The Historical Society has chosen as its Scholarship Committee: Beatrice Cornish, Arlene Woodman, Virginia Cartier and Bea Craig. Members shall serve indefinite terms. Vacancies in the Committee shall be filled by The Historical Society.
