

Willand Cemetery Fund

Condition of this fund as set forth on deposit book #16030 issued December 10 - 1912 by the Rochester Loan & Banking Company is as follows:

"This deposit is made as per condition in Will of the late Chas. W. Willand. The Executrix of will (Ada B. Berry) to be made trustee of this fund, and at her decease or retirement from said trust, her successor to be appointed by Probate Court.

The above trustee, having died, The City of Rochester was on October 2 - 1934 appointed Trustee by Jas. McCabe, Judge of Probate.

The purpose of this trust is caring for and beautifying the Willand Cemetery on Chestnut Hill in Rochester.

Clause from the Will of Charles W. Willand:

Sixth, "I direct my executor to deposit the sum of Two Hundred (200) Dollars with the Rochester Loan and Banking Company of Rochester, N. Y. in trust for the following purposes: - the principal to remain permanently with said banking company, and the income or such part as may be necessary to be expended in caring for and beautifying the Willand Cemetery, so called, on the old Willand Farm near Chestnut Hill in said Rochester where my ancestors and family are buried and where I am to be buried; and at the decease of my said executrix I direct the continuance of said trust for said purposes permanently by a trustee appointed by the Probate Court of said County of Strafford."

The City of Rochester voted to accept the above fund on November 7 - 1934.
