Water Metering of Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc.

On April 26, 2006 Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc. received correspondence from the City of Rochester regarding a shortage of payment regarding water and sewer expenses in the amount of \$18,969.72 from April of 2002 through April of 2006. Negotiations ensued and payment was made in the amount of \$9,995.70. No reasoning was ever given for the shortage and the bill continued to increase dramatically over the years.

During a City Council meeting in the summer of 2011, members of the City Council indicated that Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc. should not be provided with water and sewer services as the park was not metered and the Council members who spoke indicated that Fieldstone Village Cooperative Inc. was not paying a fair share of water and sewer costs.

Members of Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc. attended the next month's City Council meeting and advised the City Counsel that they were, in fact, paying more than there fair share of water and sewers costs in the amount of approximately \$10,000 per month (\$120,000.00 per year).

Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc. and the members of the Public Works Dept met on numerous occasions to address these issues, including the water flow, ownership of the properties and master metering the park.

In the spring of 2014, Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc. was advised by the Public Works Dept that the master meter project had been included in the City's Budget. On June 6, 2014, Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc. inquired as to the status of the City's Budget. Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc. was advised that the budget had passed and on July 7, 2014 a representative from the Public Works Dept indicated that the budget had passed.

From July 7, 2014 until today we have been in touch with the Public Works Dept in order to complete this project and we are still no further in the process of metering Fieldstone Village Cooperative, Inc.

The current water bill is \$10,817.00 per month (\$129,804 per year in water/sewer bills are being paid to the City of Rochester). The water and sewer rate is based on an average of 300 living in the park, estimated at a flat rate. There are 100 homes in the park, so each home is paying approximately \$108.17 per month in water and sewer bills at the flat rate.

A review of numerous homeowners in and around the City of Rochester indicate that the average water bill is **substantially** lower that what is being charged to Fieldstone Village Cooperative.

Representatives from Fieldstone Village will attend the next UAB Meeting to discuss a possible bill abatement on their Water and Sewer bills, as they are frustrated that installation of a City-funded master water meter has not occurred yet. Fieldstone Village has about 100 units, does not have any water meters, and is billed on a flat-rate basis which totals \$10,817.33 per month (Water = \$4162.33, Sewer = \$6655.00).

Fieldstone Village is the last remaining multi-unit flat-water customer. For the sake of comparison, we reviewed the metered use of 4 similar customers: Briar Ridge, Windswept Acres, Hideaway Village Co-op, and Moose Lane. We went back over 3 years of bills and determined that the average use was 4.5 units of water, per building, per month. Applying this baseline to Fieldstone's total units would generate a monthly, combined water and sewer metered bill of about \$4,973.

Based on current scheduling, installation of a dedicated water main and new master meter probably won't occur until May 2017. We hoped to have construction underway this fall, but there were 2 easement issues that need to be addressed, and the City's on-call contractor (S.U.R. Construction) has a backlog of work extending into the winter.

In reviewing the history of the pending project, NH DES issued the City a letter on January 11, 2013, requesting the development of a plan to meter water use at Fieldstone Village. The City subsequently retained Underwood Engineers to explore options for consideration. Based on the City's desire not to individually meter mobile homes, the recommended approach was to install a parallel water transmission main that would allow for the installation of a single master meter to serve the entire complex. Individual metering would not track any leaks within the private piping system that serves the park.

The City Council appropriated money in both the FY15 (\$150,000) & FY16 (\$300,000) budgets for a total of \$450,000 to install a new, parallel water transmission main that will run across Fieldstone

Lane. The new water main will allow the entire Fieldstone Village community to be served by one large master meter.

To provide more background information, excerpts from the Minutes of the Public Works & Building Committee are cut & pasted below where discussion of Fieldstone occurred.

July 21, 2011 - Flat Rate Water Customers-Fieldstone Village

Chairman Torr asked the Commissioner how many flat rate residential customers were on the City's water system. Commissioner Esterberg stated that this like a mobile home park or a condominium association as it considered one entity; however she further stated that there are not any single family homes on flat rate water and sewer. Chairman Torr also asked if the entire park was on the sewer system. Ms. Crawford, the park association president, stated that although several of the homes were on a pump line that pumps up to the city's line, all of the homes have city sewer. Chairman Torr asked the Commissioner to give him the average cost for water and sewer per home in this park. The Commissioner explained that the park is billed \$10,517 per month X 3 quarters = \$31,551 divided by 100 homes, would be \$315.51 per quarter per home. Chairman Torr asked the Commissioner if this would be considered a high amount. The Commissioner explained that the average four person home uses approximately twenty-four units per quarter that would be approximately \$250 per month. Ms. Crawford stated that many of these homes only have two person households. The Commissioner stated that some may have more than four as well. Chairman Torr asked why there is not a master meter as is the case in the many other mobile home parks and condominium associations in town. The Commissioner stated that the ten inch water main that runs through this park is looped to the Milton Road line and that the water runs in two directions. Your standard meter only measures one directional flow. The Commissioner stated that some of these homes are tied directly into the main line and some are tied off from smaller six and eight inch lines running down the individual streets. The Commissioner stated that there is not a practical way to put in a master meter. She further stated that the only way that the each home could be billed for actual usage was to install individual meters. The Commissioner stated that this option would not pick up the water loss that might be occurring under ground. Mayor Jean stated that we are not currently accounting for that now. Chairman Torr asked how much the individual meters would cost per home. The Commissioner stated that at a minimum it would be three hundred dollars per home for parts and installation. The Commissioner stated that they would also have to install individual shut offs in order to facilitate turning off a service for non-payment. Chairman Torr asked if there were existing shut offs. Ms. Crawford state that some homes have them and some do not. She also stated that some were not operational. Mayor Jean asked the Commissioner if it would be possible to put in a single line for this park to tie into. The Commissioner stated that it would be possible but very costly. Councilor Walker stated that a solution that would allow the individual homes to be metered and one that would account for any losses in the streets would be the best solution. He further stated that it is an idea worth exploring. Ms. Crawford stated that she has several plans that might be helpful to the City as far as determining the size of the lines with in the park. Chairman Torr suggested she get them to the people at public works. Ms Crawford stated that she would.

August 18, 2011 - Flat Rate Water Customers-Fieldstone Village

Commissioner Esterberg stated she and the City Engineer had met with Fieldstone Village's association president, Joanne Crawford. They had a lengthy discussion regarding the options that the Fieldstone community would have in regards to metering the water consumption instead of the current flat fees that they are being charged. The options discussed included putting in new water mains, mag meters and the cost of individual meters and individual water shut offs. Mrs. Crawford had stated in a prior conversation that she would bring plans depicting the water line location to the meeting. She was unable to obtain those drawings and would like to meet at a later date to further

discuss the issue. Commissioner Esterberg stated that when we hear back from Ms. Crawford then the staff would continue to assist them in finding a solution.

September 19, 2013 - Fieldstone Village Water / Metering

Mr. Nourse stated that some time ago the City had received a letter from the State of NH Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) regarding the lack of metering on this mobile home park. The letter stated the NHDES preference for meter water services. Councilor Labranche asked what the states interest is. Mr. Nourse stated that these residents are billed a flat rate which is not necessarily equitable amongst the users and conservation and leak identification as the NHDES concern. Councilors Keans and Walker suggested that the park owners are responsible to install their own meters. Councilor Varney also stated that this should not be a City expense. Mr. Nourse stated that there is conflicting information as to water mains with in the park. He said that it is not known if the water supply is just from the two directional main that flows through there then goes cross country to the Lilac Mall, or if they also are fed from an 8" line that goes directly to their system from Eastern Ave. Mr. Nourse stated that he had recently met with the new President of the Board, Jim Collins, for this co-op park. He stated that Mr. Collins is trying to come up with a plan to get the system metered. Mr. Nourse suggested that the first thing this park needs to do is establish what is underground by having a survey completed. Mr. Nourse stated that he believed that Mr. Collins is going to suggest that action to be completed to his Board and homeowners. Mr. Nourse stated that we will wait to hear back from Fieldstone Village or the state.

January 15, 2015 - Fieldstone Village Meters

Mr. Nourse stated that Underwood Engineers had been asked to look into the metering situation at Fieldstone Village. He stated this is a privately owned cooperative mobile home park off from Eastern Avenue. He stated that the State of NH had sent a letter to the City a few years back stating that the City is required to meter this Mobil home park. Councilor Torr asked how many homes were in the park. Mr. Nourse stated approximately 100 homes and that this association is paying flat rate water and sewer for each of them. He stated that it is likely when the park is metered properly we will find that they have been paying significantly more than what they would have if they had been metered. He believes that the City will be receiving as much at 30 to 50 thousand dollars less annually. He then introduced Underwood Engineers, Keith Pratt and Michael Unger. Mr. Pratt stated that he is the president of the company and he has come along to meet the Committee but he will have Mr. Unger the project manager discuss their findings. Mr. Unger stated that with help from the City staff they had done extensive investigation into the area and that they believe that all of the streets and approximately 12 to 16 homes on Village Lane are all tied into the two directional 10 inch main that flows from Eastern Avenue through the park and cross country to the Lilac Mall. Mr. Unger stated that there is an 8 inch main that comes in from Eastern Ave but it appears to terminate just inside the park. Councilor Keans asked how can they be sure that nothing is tied into that line. Mr. Unger stated that the City staff turned the gate off a few months ago and nobody had any problems with low pressure or lack of water. Mr. Unger stated that he has looked at several options for metering the water. One option was to put in a master meter at each street entrance (4) and each of the homes that are tied directly to the main (14) and then they would receive 18 invoices each month, or one totaling all meters. He further stated that an option also explored putting in a meter at each individual home, but that wouldn't solve the issue of metering for leaks which is the State of NH's concern. Mr. Unger stated that they had also looked into the installation for a mag meter that would measure two directional flows on that 10 inch main, but stated it was ruled out as the margin of error with these meters could result in significant over charges and undercharges. Mr. Unger stated that the option they would recommend would be to install a new parallel water main from Eastern Avenue through the park and tie it into the cross country line. He suggested that the section that has all of the streets and homes tied into it could then be isolated and a master meter could be installed that would meter

the parks consumption. Councilor Varney asked the cost of this option. Mr. Unger stated that costs could run from \$287,000 to \$367,000. Mr. Nourse stated that he had discussed the project with a local contractor and if done as a design build project it might be completed for \$275,000. There was discussion of how Fieldstone Village might participate in the cost of the water main project. Mr. Nourse stated that with the fees they are currently paying they are unable to fund much of this. Mr. Nourse stated that he has remaining funds and he has put the project into the proposed FY2016 CIP. Councilor Varney liked the idea of having the Co-op fund some of the cost with the monthly savings for a time period to be determined and set up in advance with a written agreement. He suggested that the City attempt to negotiate something with the park.

January 21, 2016 - Fieldstone Village Meter Project.

Councilor Varney asked about the status. Mr. Storer stated that he would look into the status and get back to the Committee.

February 18, 2016 - Fieldstone Village

Mr. Storer stated that since the mention of this project at last month's committee meeting he has met with staff and reviewed the consultant reports to determine the scope of the project. He stated that he has also been discussing the project with Mr. Creteau from SUR Construction. Mr. Storer stated that the department would like to do the project as a design build with SUR using the pricing in the Construction Contracted Services bid to save the City the expense of drawing up bid documents and going out to formal bid. Mr. Storer stated that the project basically entails running a parallel line down Village Lane to tie in the existing lines and services to that main. He stated that we would have a master meter for billing and determining leaks within the private piping servicing the cooperative. This would meet the Co-ops expectations and the State of NH expectations.

March 17, 2016 - Fieldstone Village Water Meter

Mr. Storer stated that he had met with the City contracted service vendor in regards to the project. He stated that they had come up with a plan that is well within the limits of the current funding. He stated he had also met with the Co-Op Officers regarding their ability to participate in cost sharing. He stated that it was not likely they would be able to contribute financially and thought he should let the Committee know.

MINUTES

1. Call to order:

Chairman Peterson called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

2. Appeals -

2.1 504 Oakridge Condo - Robert Lemoine

The appellant, Robert Lemoine was present. Mr. Lemoine stated that he had no additional documents to provide as requested at last month's meeting and has no explanation for the usage. The meter test came back normal. New tenants moved in on 2/1/2016 and the property had set vacant for a couple of months before that. Mr. Lemoine stated they did not see any leaks. After a discussion on the new Water & Sewer Adjustment policy, the board made the following motions.

Mr. Willis made a motion to abate 50% of the above average water & sewer use per the new policy. The motion stipulated that the water abatement is \$420.88 (87.5 units). The sewer abatement is \$546.00 (87.5. The motion also stipulated the abatement of all accrued interest. Mr. Libby seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2.2 83 Brock Street, Holy Rosary Cemetery – Norby Haman

The appellant Mr. Hamann was present. Mr. Hamann explained that there are two meters on the cemetery property, one for outside watering and one for a locked bathroom for two employees only. The high usage was in the bathroom meter. Mr. Hamann stated that the meter has been pulled to be tested by the city.

Chairman Peterson made a motion to table the appeal until the meter test result comes back. Mr. Willis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2.3 665 Portland Street – Matthew Cheney

The appellant was not present for the meeting. This appeal was tabled last month to allow further information to be given by the homeowner. Mr. Cheney informed the Billing Office Staff that he found a toilet running intermittently in his home and that it was repaired. The board discussed the abatement request. The water was used, it did enter the sewer system, and the usage does not meet the criteria for new Water and Sewer Adjustment policy. The following motions were made.

Mr. Willis made a motion to deny the requested abatement. Chairman Peterson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2.4 29 Park Street – Courtney Morgridge

The appellant was not present for the meeting. Director John Storer explained that he was unable to establish an average use due to fluctuations in new owners meter readings so he determined an abatement amount based on the dimensions of the foundation and assumed the 4 inches of standing water as indicated on Ms. Morgridge's appeal.

Chairman Peterson made a motion to abate 3 units of sewer at \$6.24 each for a total of \$18.72 plus all accrued interest. Mr. Libby seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2.5 30-32 Common Street – Kenneth Powers

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The abatement requested was for \$60 for on/off charges for non-payment. Mr. Libby referenced the pertaining City Ordinances and the Board made the following motions.

Mr. Libby made a motion to deny the requested abatement. Mr. Willis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2.6 13 Jacobs Drive – Robert Roper

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The board discussed the appeal which noted that both toilets at the property were leaking and were repaired by a plumber. *Mr. Willis made a motion to deny the requested abatement. Chairman Peterson seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.*

3. Approval of the July 18, 2016 Minutes

Mr. Willis made a motion to accept the July 18, 2016 meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Libby. The motion passed unanimously.

4. New Water and Sewer Adjustment Policy

The Board had a brief discussion regarding this policy. The Board noted the one time

in a ten year period for adjustment. They stressed that property owners will need to be made clear on that portion of the policy.

5. October 2016 Meeting Date

The Board discussed availability for October's meeting as the next scheduled meeting falls on Columbus Day. The Board agreed on a new date of Tuesday, October 11th, 2016 at 5:30PM pending availability of the City Council Conference Room.

6. Resignation

Chairman Peterson gave his resignation beginning January 2017. The board wished him well.

7. Adjournment:

Chairman Peterson made a motion to adjourn at 6:17PM. The motion was seconded by Mr. Willis. The motion passed unanimously.

The attached appeal has been reviewed in accordance with the provisions of the City of Rochester Ordinances, Chapter 16 "Sewer Ordinance" subsection 16.18 "Appeals," and Chapter 17 "Water" subsection 17.20 "Appeals."

Recommendations

I recommend an abatement of 74 units of water and sewer on the invoiced amount.

The above recommendation is based upon the following findings:

- 1. Per City Ordinance 17.20 Appeals: In the event the abnormally high consumption has occurred due to "unpredictable leakage" not caused by customer negligence, ignorance or unfortunate circumstances, as determined by City staff and the Utility Advisory Board, the City shall consider granting a one-time abatement, per account, during any ten-year period, up to half of the water consumption above normal consumption.
- 2. May 2016 bill was high due to leaking toilet that has been repaired.

Recommendations

Recommendations

We are requesting an appeal for our water bill dated April 8, 2016-July 11, 2016. There must be a technical, mechanical or human error because our bill has double since the last one. We were in hopes that our bill would have be significantly lower do to several changes to help decrease water use and save energy. Over the last several months we have invested in Energy Saving appliances. In particular a new washing machine that uses ¼ less water compared to that of our old washer. We invested in plumbing services to update and replace old fixtures and pipes. If needed, I would be happy to provide receipts and invoices for our new appliances or plumbing work done. We thought the repairs and updates would decrease our water use and help conserve not increase. We did not/do not have any leaky pipes or toilets. Our present bills show a huge increase although we haven't watered our lawn since the summer of 2014 due to poor drainage issues and a lawn not worthy of watering. We have no gardens or pool. There are no additional people living in our house, just the 2 of us (as before) and we are not home 50-62 hours a week due to our work schedules. The indoor water meter seems to be working properly. We would appreciate your help resolving this error.

1. Call to order:

He stated that he is unsure how long it had been left running but he was hoping that the City could abate the sewer portion of his bill for above average use. He stated that he was sure it ran into the ground and not into the sewer system.

Mr. Willis made a motion to abate 40 units of sewer at \$6.24 each, for a total of \$249.60, plus all accrued interest. Mr. Libby seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

2.2 Amy Lavoie, #59 Ten Rod Road

The appellant was present at the meeting. She stated that she had been watering her lawn but did not think that watering would use this much water. She stated that the Water Dept technician had come out to check the meter and it is working properly. Ms. Lavoie did ask about the process of installing a sewer deduct meter and was referred to the billing office for possible installation and additional information. Mr. Willis made a motion to abate the 42 units of sewer valued at \$6.24 each, for a total of \$262.08, plus all accrued interest. Mr. Libby seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

We are writing to appeal our recent water bill. The church had a fire back in March of 2016. Subsequently, since that fire we have had only construction work on that side of the building. Having said that it was only discovered on 9/17/16 that the hot water heater had been leaking for some time now. Since there is little to no activity on this side of the building we were unaware of the leak and the effect it could have had on our Water/Sewer bill. We were able to obtain a submersible pump and figured we pumped out close to 430 gallons of water. The pumping occurred two separate time periods during this last quarterly billing period.

We are now in the process of replacing the hot water heater. Attached please find a proposal for replacement which is scheduled to be done on 9/30/2016.
