MINUTES

1. Call to order:

Chairman Libby called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

2. Approval of September 10, 2018 Minutes

Mr. Boudreau made a motion to accept the September 10, 2018 meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Appeals –

3.1 760 Portland St – Timothy Chalifour

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal was for excess sewer usage due to a leak in the irrigation system.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to abate the above average sewer usage on the June and September 2018 invoices, or 29 units of sewer at \$195.75, plus accrued interest per the recommendation. The motion was seconded by Mr. Boudreau. The motion passed unanimously.

3.2 5 Blair Dr – Paul & Denise Schweinsberg

The appellants were not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average sewer usage due to a faulty sewer deduct meter. The meter was replaced.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to abate the above average sewer on the August invoice and upcoming November invoice plus any accrued interest. The motion was seconded by Chairman Libby. The motion passed unanimously.

3.3 17 Gagne St – Miranda Royer

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average usage. The appellant did not find any leaks and the meter has been sent for testing. Chairman Libby made a motion to table the appeal until the meter test results are received. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

3.4 4 Blair Dr – Daniel Bilodeau

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average sewer usage due to a faulty sewer deduct meter. The meter has been replaced.

Chairman Libby made a motion to abate the above average sewer on the August invoice and upcoming November invoice plus any accrued interest. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

3.5 72 Lafayette St – RAMA

Nancy Gilbert was present for the meeting. The request is for an abatement per the City's Policy on Water & Sewer Adjustments. The policy allows for an abatement of ½ of the above average water used, and per the appeal the high usage was due to a pipe leak in the Exhibition Building. The pipe was repaired by RAMA staff. There was discussion regarding the once in ten-year policy per location, per property, per meter or per building.

Chairman Libby made a motion to abate 371 units of water at \$5.55 each for a total of \$2,059.05. The abatement is for the Exhibition Hall meter on the August invoice plus any accrued interest. The motion stated that the decision letter and account would note that this is a once in ten-year abatement for the Exhibition Hall location. The motion was seconded by Mr. Boudreau. The motion passed unanimously.

3.6 96 A Trinity Circle – Karen Cofferen

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average sewer usage due to a hot water heater that leaked. The leak has been repaired.

Chairman Libby made a motion to abate 7 units of sewer at \$47.25 plus any accrued interest. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

3.7 90 Big Bear Rd – Neal Roberts

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average sewer usage due to faulty installation of the sewer deduct meter. This has been repaired.

Mr. Boudreau made a motion to abate the above average sewer on the August invoice and upcoming November invoice plus any accrued interest. Chairman Libby seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

3.8 47 Blair Dr – Pierre & Laurette Beaulieu

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average water and sewer usage due to a leak in an underground pipe and a faulty sewer deduct meter. These have both been repaired.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to abate the above average sewer usage with the choice of abating ½ of the above average water usage on the August and upcoming November invoice plus any accrued interest. If the homeowner chooses to accept the water abatement, the decision letter and account will note that this is a once in ten year abatement. The motion was seconded by Chairman Libby. The motion passed unanimously.

3.9 108 Maple St – Marian L Veno

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average usage due to a toilet leak. The leak has been repaired.

Chairman Libby made a motion to abate 25 units of water at \$138.75 and 25 units of sewer at \$168.75 for a total abatement of \$307.50 plus any accrued interest. The motion stated the decision letter and account will note that this is a once in ten year abatement. The motion was seconded by Mr. Boudreau. The motion passed unanimously.

3.10 13 Kendall St – James Hand

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average sewer usage due to a leaking automatic waterer.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to abate the above average sewer on the August invoice and upcoming November invoice. The motion stated that the decision letter will recommend installing a sewer deduct meter. The motion was seconded by Mr. Sanders. The motion passed unanimously.

3.11 23 Temple Dr – Dale & Patricia Officer

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average sewer usage due to a faulty sewer deduct meter. The meter has been replaced.

Chairman Libby made a motion to abate the above average sewer on the August invoice and upcoming November invoice plus any accrued interest. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Financials

Mr. Boudreau made inquiries regarding the financial reports. Ms. Clark responded.

5. Adjournment:

Chairman Libby made a motion to adjourn at 6:30PM. The motion was seconded by Mr. Boudreau. The motion passed unanimously.

The attached appeal has been reviewed in accordance with the provisions of the City of Rochester Ordinances, Chapter 16 "Sewer Ordinance" subsection 16.18 "Appeals," and Chapter 17 "Water" subsection 17.20 "Appeals."

Recommendations

I recommend no abatement on the invoiced amount.

The above recommendation is based upon the following findings:

- 1. The appellant is responsible for all usage and/or undetected water leaks on the property.
- 2. Per Section 2 in the Policy on Water & Sewer Adjustments:

"In the event that a customer cannot determine the source or cause of the abnormally high consumption, the customer is required to hire a private licensed plumber to assist the customer in trying to determine the cause. If the plumber is unable to determine the source or cause of the abnormally high consumption, the City can only speculate that the customer has located and repaired or corrected said source. If the customer claims that said source never existed, the City shall test the meter and make an adjustment to the bill in accordance with the requirements stipulated in the City Ordinance 17.12(d) for meter found to be inaccurate based on the American Water Works Association (AWWA) standards. If the meter test reveals an accurate or under-recording meter the customer shall be held responsible for the entire bill plus the cost of meter testing, shipping and handling."

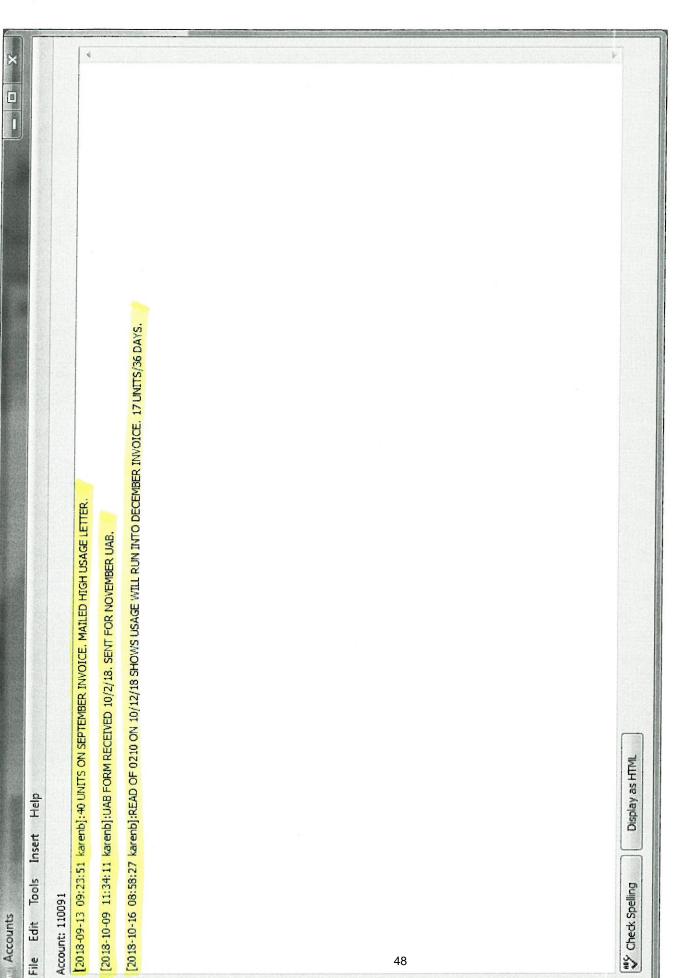

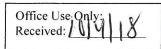

thanks for the information that was very helpful, as there was no leak in regard to the usage, it was for exceptional circumstances due to watering the lawn as it was in such poor shape when we bought the home in 2017. We paid a lawn care company to treat the lawn during the summer and this treatment required a lot of water to get the treatments to pay off. Our front and back yard is very big and without a sprinkler system it meant using a walking sprinkler to cover the nearly half an acre of lawn. This was of course compounded by a dry hot summer.

So technically we did use the water but we were shocked by the amount of the bill.

So long story short, not sure how we should go, whatever is going to help me reduce this amount by appeal or as a hardship problem due to my wife out of work and myself retired being treated for cancer in Boston for which treatments can be expensive. I guess when I filed the appeal it was an attempt to reduce the bill by asking that the water be classed as sewer water thus lowering the bill?

Good morning, James,

If you cannot make it, please do not stress. It is not mandatory that you go and I can pass onto the Board that your intention was to come. I just wanted to follow up on the appeal, I wanted to be sure if I told you about the policy on water appeals. For sewer, you are eligible for 100% of the above average usage back because it did not go into the sewer system. For water appeals, you can only do a water appeal once in ten years per property and it is only for half of the above average usage. The water portion of your appeal will likely be: 82 units -19 units (average) = 63 units. Half of 63 = 31.5 units, so 32 units $\times 5.55$ /unit = \$177.60.

Please verify if you are still asking for the water appeal, knowing that should you have any future leaks within the next ten years, you will only be able to file an appeal for sewer if it does not go through the sewer system.
