MINUTES

1. Call to order:

Chairman Libby called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM.

2. Agenda Item 3.5 40 Millers Farm Dr. – Nickerson

The appellant was present for the meeting. This appeal was for above average water and sewer usage due to a contractor using her outside spicket. The appellant chose to forgo the water appeal due to the 10 year limitation on future abatements. Ms. Clark suggested a long term payment arrangement if needed.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to abate 55 units of sewer at \$6.75 each for a total of \$371.25 plus any accrued interest on the January invoice. The motion was seconded by Mr. Libby. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Approval March 11, 2019 Minutes

Chairman Libby made a motion to accept the March 11, 2019 meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Appeals -

3.1 72 Lafayette - RAMA

The appellant was not present for the meeting. It was decided that it will be tabled to allow RAMA time to collect on the invoiced amount from there lessee in order to determine an amount to request for abatement

Chairman Libby made a motion to table this abatement. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

3.2 12 Blair Dr. - Houston

The appellant was not present for the meeting. Appeal was for above average usage due to a dead sewer deduct. There was discussion regarding policy on timely filing of appeal.

Mr. Barnes made a motion to deny the abatement request. The motion was seconded by Chairman Libby. The motion passed unanimously.

3.3 179 Milton Rd. - Seagate Limited Partnership 11

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal was for above average usage due to burst pipes.

Mr. Johnson made a motion to abate 312 units of sewer at \$6.75 each for a total of \$1,731.60 on the March invoice 2019 plus any accrued interest. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

3.4 18 Lafayette St. - Locke

The appellant was not present for the meeting. The appeal is for above average water and sewer due to a leaking toilet. There was discussion as to negligence because toilet was turned off for a period of time instead of fixing the problem.

Mr. Johnson made a motion to deny abatement. The motion was seconded by Mr. Sanders. The motion passed unanimously.

5. Financials

Mr. Boudreau made inquiries regarding the financial reports. Ms. Clark responded.

6. Adjournment:

Chairman Libby made a motion to adjourn at 6:32PM. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barnes. The motion passed unanimously.

The attached appeal has been reviewed in accordance with the provisions of the City of Rochester Ordinances, Chapter 16 "Sewer Ordinance" subsection 16.18 "Appeals," and Chapter 17 "Water" subsection 17.20 "Appeals."

Recommendations

I recommend an abatement of 78 units of water and sewer on the Dec 2018 and Mar 2019 invoiced amounts plus half of the above average usage on the June 2019 invoice once issued. The decision letter and account will be noted with the language that this is a once in 10 year abatement for this property.

The above recommendation is based upon the following findings:

- 1. The owner does not dispute the meter reading and has found numerous leaks at property.
 - a. Total usage on disputed invoices:

Dec '18 (116) Mar '19 (128) 244 Units b. Average use on previous three years is 44 (44*2) is: 88 Units c. Estimated use over average 156 Units d. ½ of above average use equals

78 Units

Value of 78 Units of Water at the current water rate of \$5.55 = \$432.50. Value of 78 Units of Sewer at the current sewer rate of \$6.75 = \$526.50.

Total abatement = \$959.40 plus accrued interest.

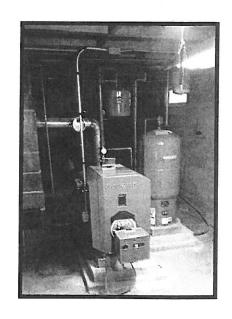

Good Afternoon Nancy,

Nate and I have discussed the invoice and the estimated bill for RAMA's Invoice for the consumption on the hydrant meter requested and signed for by RAMA.

The meter was brought to fairgrounds early on 1/8/19 and read 1011 at time of install as documented on the sheet signed by RAMA Rep (attached).

The meter was documented on the same date, 1/8/19 at 10AM (attached photo) to be reading 1121 (already used 110 units to get set up and with only one snow gun in operation).

The next few days (Tues through Thursday) it was raining and snow making was suspended until late afternoon Thursday. At that time a second gun was placed on line and they began snow making.

The Friday reading 10AM of 1554 (1/11/19 attached photo) means that after approximately 16 hours of operating they had used 430 units of water (27 units per hour).

When the hydrant meter was returned 1/24/19 after numerous calls and attempts to get this meter back. The reading was 1466, which is 88 units less than what the reading was on the last documented read, see picture for 1/11/19. This means for some reason the meter was hooked up to a water source and run backwards. This left us with no choice but to estimate the water consumption based on the previous two reads.

After the Friday reading they continued to blow snow for an additional 24 hours using two guns, finishing up Sat at 10am at the start of the event. This end time was witnessed by staff. That would be 24 hours x 27 Units = 648. We also believe the snow guns were run over night Saturday into Sunday. Nate estimated 8 hours x 27 units = 221. For a total of 1409 units of water, which was billed.
